Minutes of the Regular ESD 7 Business Meeting

Tuesday, April 14, at 6:00 pm Station 41

The meeting was called to order by ESD 7 President Edward Belding at 6:20 pm.

The invocation was given by Edward Belding, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

- 1. Review and Approve the Minutes of the Regular Business Meeting of March 10, 2026** – A motion to approve the minutes as written was made by Treasurer, Elizabeth Bozzell and seconded by Commissioner Gene Payne. The motion passed unanimously.
- 2. Present Service Provider Reports and Review Call Volume** – Service Provider reports were presented by Assistant Chief Ortiz for Millsap Fire/Rescue. President Belding asked if grants were available to cover costs for future mandated health screenings. Chief Robertson indicated efforts to identify any available grants will be made at the appropriate time. Chief Young presented the service provider report for Greenwood Rural VFD. Assistant Chief Robertson presented the service provider report for Cool Garner VFD. Assistant Chief Robertson reported that the Fort Worth training facility was rented for the large water call in May. The call volume reports were reviewed.
- 3. Present and Approve the Treasurer's Report and Check Detail for February 2026** – A motion to approve the Treasurer's Report and Check Detail as presented was made by Commissioner Gene Payne and seconded by President Edward Belding. The motion passed unanimously.
- 4. Request for Public Comment** – None
- 5. Discuss and Take any Necessary Action on New Station Build in Cool** – Chief Robertson reported that he and Assistant Chief Robertson met with Mr. Randy Landers approximately three weeks prior to discuss project progress. It was reported that Mr. Landers is waiting for the engineering study and a follow-up discussion with the Chief will take place in the upcoming weeks. President Belding stated his reservations about project lag time and potential cost implications.

6. Chief Robertson

- a. **Discuss and take any necessary action on a Quote for Bed replacement with all DOT marker lights, compartment boxes with baskets on top, hose tray and mounting and plumbing skid unit. \$6,663.00** - A motion to approve the payment of the costs was made by Treasurer, Elizabeth Bozzell and seconded by Commissioner Gene Payne. The motion passed unanimously.
- b. **Discuss and take any necessary action on the RMS Quote. We currently have a total of 4 different entities that are interested in sharing this expense, reducing the cost impact for each entity** – This item will appear on the May agenda wherein Chief Robertson will continue to provide information regarding district size and cost.

7. Assistant Chief

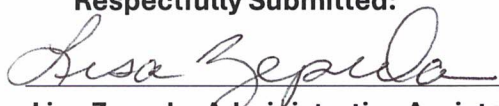
- a. **Discuss and take necessary action to pay TDSHS license renewal by auto draft** – A motion to approve the requested auto draft was made by Treasurer Elizabeth Bozzell and seconded by Commissioner Gene Payne. The motion passed unanimously.
- b. **Discuss and take necessary action to obtain membership to Sams for purchase of station and office supplies** – Assistant Chief Robertson explained the desire to streamline the purchase of supplies reducing cost and frequency of orders where possible. A request for approval to obtain membership of Sam’s Club was presented. Sam’s Club business membership fees are currently \$60/year for a basic Club card and \$120/year for a Plus membership. A motion to approve the cost for membership was made by Commissioner Gene Payne and seconded by Treasurer Elizabeth Bozzell. The motion passed unanimously.
- c. **Discuss and take necessary action to adopt the Vision Statement** – The Commission acknowledged and expressed support for the Statement. A vote is not required.

9. Adjournment – President Edward Belding made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Treasurer Elizabeth Bozzell and unanimously approved. The time was 7:16 pm.
